








Comic Books: Reading Correlations

Grade Level Readability

Read a comic last week & reading proficiency r = .36 (read a book, r = .26)

Comic Book reading and reading proficiency Elley (1994): 9 and 10 year olds in 27 countries


The Incredible Hulk:




- Library as the first place

- Multimodal texts (multiple literacies)
- Concise and efficient writing
- Higher memory retention
